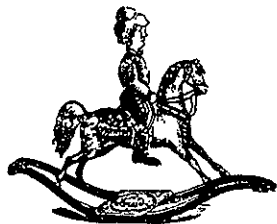

The Coconut Grove Restaurant was built in the time of the Model T Fords, in 1927, by Carl and Sam Lupica. It was operated as a gas station at first. This was the time of prohibition when alcoholic beverages were prohibited for sale by the Federal Government, but "rumor" has it that alcohol could be purchased not only for the car but also for the drivers. This was the time of Al Capone, Dutch Schults and many other bootleggers who were peddling illegal beer and liquor all the way from Canada to Miami, Florida. So in 1933 they repealed the law and made beer and liquor legal. The Coconut Grove then started selling food along with the new legal beverages and soon became a popular dining establishment, famous for steaks and spaghetti. Because of the short stature of the owners the place soon became known as "Shorties", a name that has stayed with it to this day, though the right name is Coconut Grove.

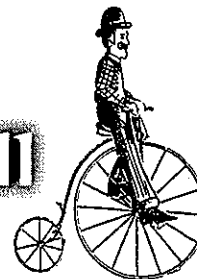
